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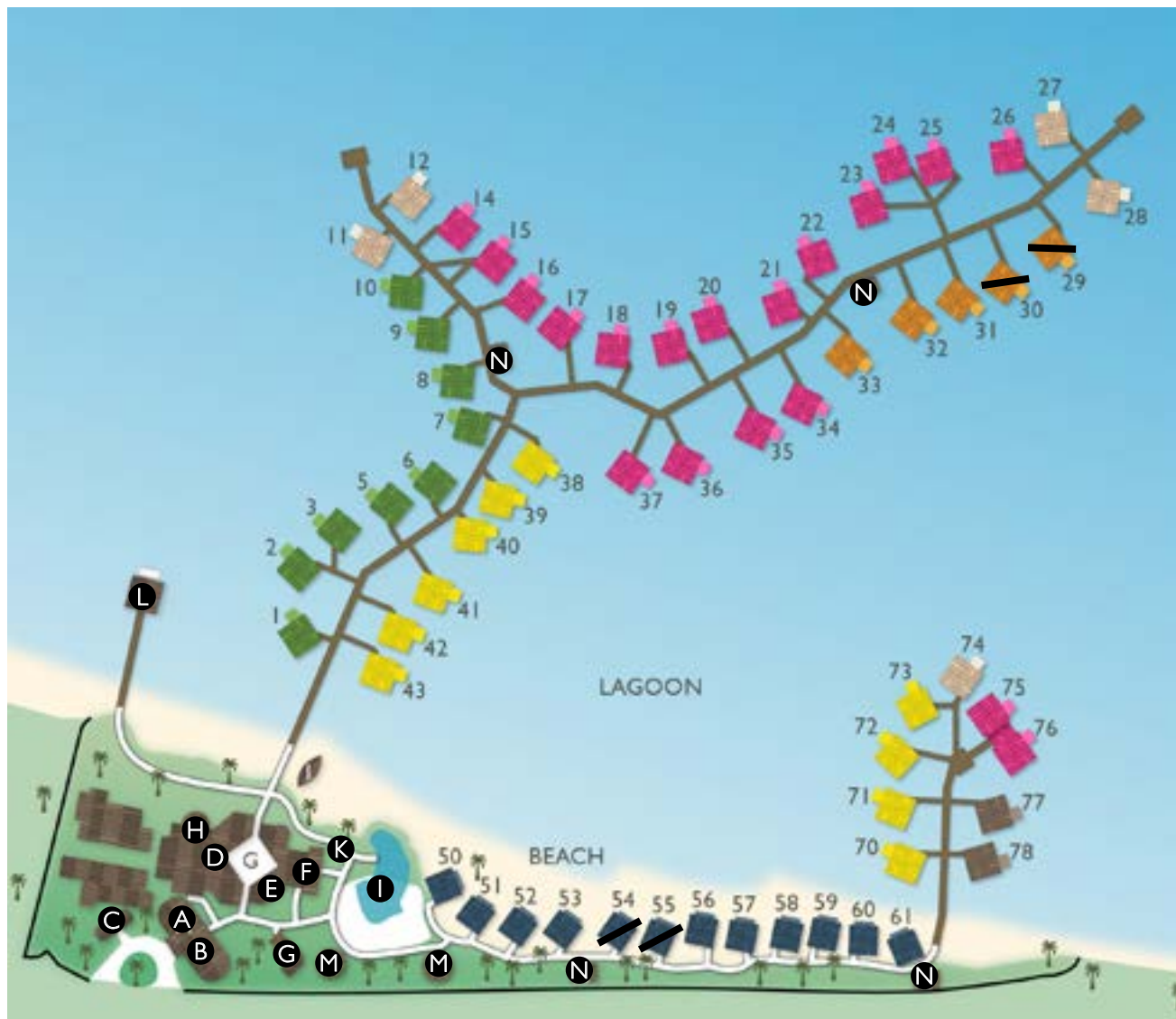

Perched along the shoreline between coconut palms, our Beach Bungalows Lagoon View offer 36 square meters (387 square feet) of indoor space, opening onto the beachfront with direct access to the pristine waters of the lagoon.

The bedroom features a king-size bed, separate living area with a sofa-bed and a spacious bathroom with separate shower and bathtub. There is also a wide private terrace with two deck chairs, a solarium and an outdoor shower.

Perfect for families, the Poevai overwater suite - two lagoon-view overwater bungalow linked by a 20-square-meter living room - can accommodate up to four adults and two children.
