

# HOTEL FACT SHEET

In the heart of the Leeward Islands, the private motu Tu Vahine, in Taha'a, immerses you in authentic Polynesia.


Surrounded by a crystal-clear blue lagoon and a preserved reef, it is home to a coconut grove and an exceptional coral garden.

From its beaches, the view opens up to Bora Bora, Huahine, Taha'a, and Raiatea, for a truly breathtaking setting.




Nestled in lush vegetation on the edge of the lagoon, it offers a selection of treatments inspired by local traditions.

Designed to revitalize the skin and release tension, our treatments cater to both travelers seeking rest and those drawn to authentic rituals.











## **BEACH BUNGALOW**

Direct beach access allows you to explore the surrounding coral gardens and discover the protected marine life.

















## **BEACH SUITES**
















## **OVERWATER BUNGALOWS**


Inside the bungalows, a glass coffee table invites guests to contemplate the lagoon's biodiversity, creating a harmonious connection with nature.
















### **ROYAL VILLA**

## WEDDING & ROMANTIC SERVICES

Between a crystal-clear lagoon and the endless ocean, our private island offers a preserved and tranquil setting to celebrate a special moment as a couple—be it a vow renewal or a traditional Polynesian ceremony.

A Tahitian priest (Tahu'a), dressed in ceremonial attire, officiates the union in the local language. The blessing with coconut water is followed by a symbolic ritual: the couple is wrapped in a tifaifai (a traditional Polynesian quilt) and receives a marriage certificate inscribed on tapa, a bark cloth crafted according to ancestral customs.
